BFS School Performer 2010 for performers under the age of 19 years

This new competition is open to all flute players under the age of 19 years. The panel of distinguished adjudicators will include Atarah Ben-Tovim MBE, Ruth Morley of the Scottish Flute Trio and RSAMD flute department, and Tony Ovenell, former Principal Flute of the RLPO.

Competitors should play a piece of their own choice and must not exceed the maximum time allowed for their class. Competitors may perform on a piccolo, alto or bass flute if they prefer. The title of the piece must be submitted upon application. An official accompanist is available.

There are two classes:

Prizes will be awarded for each class and the winner of Class B will be invited to perform at the 2010 BFS International Convention. Written feedback and a certificate of attendance will be given to each competitor.

BFS Young Artist 2010 for performers under the age of 25 years

This new competition is open to all flute players under the age of 25 years and will give advanced students a prestigious platform as they near the end of their studies.

Competitors should play a piece of their own choice lasting no longer than 8 minutes. Competitors may perform on a piccolo, alto or bass flute if they prefer. The title of the piece must be submitted upon application. An official accompanist will be provided with time allotted for rehearsal.

Prizes will be awarded at the end of the class and the winner will be invited to perform at the 2010 BFS International Convention. Written feedback and a certificate of attendance will be given to each competitor.
