BFS School Performer 2018

This competition is open to flute players aged 13 years and under on 31 August 2018. Competitors should play a piece or pieces of their own choice and **the performance as a whole (incl. breaks) must not exceed 5 minutes**. The title of the piece(s) must be submitted upon application.

Competitors may perform on a piccolo, alto or bass flute if they prefer. An official accompanist will be provided with time allotted for a short top-and-tail rehearsal.

Approximate standard: Grade 5 or above

BFS Young Performer 2018

This competition is open to flute players aged 14-18 years on 31 August 2018. Competitors should play a piece or pieces of their own choice and **the performance as a whole (incl. breaks) must not exceed 7 minutes**. The title of the piece(s) must be submitted upon application.

Competitors may perform on a piccolo, alto or bass flute if they prefer. An official accompanist will be provided with time allotted for a short top-and-tail rehearsal.

Approximate standard: Grade 7-8 or above

At the end of each competition, the adjudicator will lead a plenary session and prizes will be awarded. Written feedback and a certificate of attendance will be given to each competitor. Competitors are encouraged to stay and listen to other classes.

BFS Young Artist 2018

Competitors aged 19-24 years on 31 August 2018

Approximate standard: Grade 8 or above
Performance duration: up to 8 minutes

This competition is particularly suitable for those studying at a higher level. Competitors should play a piece or pieces of their own choice and **the performance as a whole (incl. breaks) must not exceed 8 minutes**. The title of the piece (s) must be submitted upon application.

Competitors may perform on a piccolo, alto or bass flute if they prefer. An official accompanist will be provided with time allotted for a short rehearsal. Prizes will be awarded at the end of the class. Written feedback and a certificate of attendance will be given to each competitor.
