PERSONS NOT ALLOWED TO ACT AS TRUSTEES

Under section 72 of the Charities Act 1993, certain people are disqualified from acting as charity trustees. These include people who:

- have been convicted at any time of any offence involving deception or dishonesty, unless the conviction is legally regarded as spent; or
- are undischarged bankrupts; or
- have made a composition with their creditors and have not been discharged; or
- have at any time been removed from a position as a trustee by the Charity Commissioners or by the Court in England, Wales or Scotland because of misconduct; or
- are disqualified from being a company director under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986; or
- have failed to make payments under county court administration orders.
- No person under the age of 18 may act as a trustee.

DECLARATION

In relation to my responsibilities, if elected as a member of the British Flute Society's council, as a trustee of The British Flute Society, I hereby declare as follows:-

- I am over 18 and not disqualified under section 72 of the Charities Act 1993 from being a trustee for any of the reasons summarized above; and
